We would like to invite you to submit your articles in Spanish, and we will translate them into English after they have been approved by our editorial committee, comprised of the following doctors: Abelardo Meneses, José Luis Aguilar, Óscar Arrieta Rodríguez, Charles Balch, Luis Benítez-Bribiesca, Jesús García-Foncillas, Alejandro Mohar and Vicente Valero, as well as the Executive Secretary, Paula Juárez.
